Denis Schapiro is an Independent Fellow at the Harvard Medical School and the Broad Institute mentored by Prof. Peter Sorger and Prof. Aviv Regev. His research focuses on spatially resolved highly multiplexed imaging methods and analysis.

Denis received his PhD from the University of Zurich and ETH Zurich in the laboratory of Prof. Bernd Bodenmiller where he developed the computational pipeline for Imaging Mass Cytometry tailored to investigate the tumor ecosystem.

Prior, he studied Technical Biology at the University of Stuttgart including a research project in the laboratory of Prof. Alfred Goldberg at the Harvard Medical School working on protein degradation, an internship at Bayer AG focusing on PBPK modeling and a master thesis in the laboratory of Prof. Peter Sorger at the Harvard Medical School working on cellular signaling.

Denis received several awards for his research including an Exceptional Student Award at CYTO 2016 for his work on “histoCAT”.
