Brian T. Grimberg, Ph.D. is an Assistant Professor of International Health at the Center for Global Health & Diseases, in the Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine located in Cleveland, OH, USA.

Dr. Grimberg attended the University of Rochester as an undergraduate and received his doctorate from Wake Forest University. Then he performed two National Research Service Award sponsored fellowships in Geographic Medicine and Hematology at CWRU and University Hospitals Case Medical Center.

Professional interests include: cytometric analysis of malaria parasite species particularly; *P. vivax*, *P. knowlesi*, and *P. falciparum*. He performs high throughput drug screening for novel antimalarial compounds and investigates the induction of parasite apoptosis-like mechanisms for new treatments. Also by focusing on parasite:ligand interactions he searches for new vaccine candidates for *P. vivax*.
