Gerald T. Nepom, MD, PhD Benaroya Research Institute

Dr. Nepom is Director of Benaroya Research Institute (BRI) at Virginia Mason, in Seattle WA, and Director of the Immune Tolerance Network (ITN), sponsored by the National Institutes of Health. His primary research interests focus on characterization of the human CD4 T cell response in autoimmunity, with an emphasis on type 1 diabetes (T1D), as well as the translation of immunological intervention strategies into innovative clinical trials. Dr. Nepom also serves as an advisor for many academic and nonprofit organizations involved in biomedical research and is past president of FOCIS, the Federation of Clinical Immunology Societies. He has published over 300 scientific papers and won several awards, including the University of Washington School of Medicine Distinguished Alumni Award and the David Rumbough Award for Scientific Excellence from the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation.
