Monica L. Guzman, PhD, is an Assistant Professor of Pharmacology in Medicine, in the Division of Hematology and Medical Oncology at Weill Cornell Medical College. She obtained her doctorate degree at the University of Kentucky and completed her postdoctoral training at the University of Rochester.

Dr. Guzman leads a research program focused on the development of therapeutic strategies for targeting leukemic stem cells. In close collaboration with physicians and industry, her research has resulted in the translation of laboratory findings into two phase 1 clinical trials.

She has authored and co-authored more than 20 papers in the field and has received funding from The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, NIH, V Foundation, and the Lauri Strauss Leukemia Foundation, among other organizations.

Dr. Guzman is the recipient of the NIH Director's Innovator Award and the V Foundation Scholar Award, both in 2010.
